

Dear Parents/Carers,

Instrumental Music Lessons 2011/2012

The Juli Music Centre is offering private Instrumental Music lessons at AIS for the new school year. The classes available are Piano, Violin, Guitar and Drum.

Classes for Piano, Drum and Violin are only available as individual lessons whereas guitar is available individually or in small groups (2 – 3 students).

Individual lessons and group lessons of 30 minutes will be held during class time on a rotational basis so that students are not missing the same subjects every week.

Lessons will be held on **Mondays** from 8.10am – 12.40pm and will commence on **Monday 26th September 2011**.

Number of Lessons and Fees per term in 2011/2012:

Term 1: 11 weeks Individual – dh 1089, Group – dh 786.5

Term 2: 10 weeks Individual – dh 990, Group – dh 715

Term 3: 10 weeks Individual – dh 990, Group – dh 715

***The Juli Music Centre has kept tuition fees the same so as to encourage more students into the music programme.**

*Enrolment in music lessons is for the **whole** year and **half a term's notice in writing is required** for a student to withdraw from the programme. It is assumed that students will continue with their lessons for the whole year and fees will become due at the beginning of each term. This change in procedure is to better plan for the number of teachers required.

Lesson fees are paid in advance before the beginning of each new term. Once paid, fees are non-refundable. When a teacher misses a lesson the teacher will catch up that missed lesson at another time during the term.

A piano, keyboard and drum kit are available for lessons on these instruments. Students must provide their own instruments for lessons on other instruments. Drum students require their own set of drumsticks. These can be purchased or rented from the Juli Music Centre. Please contact them on 043212588 for pricing information.

To enrol, please complete the attached form and return with your payment by Monday 19th September 2011 to Miss Jodi's office in C Block Reception. Fees must be paid in advance for your child to be considered in the programme.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available. If your child does not receive a place in the music programme this term they will be placed on a waiting list and the fees refunded to you.
